Auto Industry produces more vehicles during April-February

The industry produced a total 28,735,269 vehicles including passenger vehicles, commercial vehicles, three wheelers, two wheelers and quadricycle in April-February 2019 as against 26,421,110 in April-February 2018, registering a growth of 8.76 per cent over the same period last year.

The sale of passenger vehicles grew by 3.27 per cent in April-February 2019 over the same period last year. Within the passenger vehicles, the sales of passenger cars, utility vehicle & vans grew by 2.91 per cent, 2.09 per cent and 13.05 per cent respectively in April-February 2019 over the same period last year.

The overall commercial vehicles segment registered a growth of 19.71 per cent in April-



February 2019 as compared to the same period last year. Medium & heavy commercial vehicles (M&HCVs) increased by 17.65 per cent and light commercial vehicles grew by 21.05 per cent in April-February 2019 over the same period last year.

Three Wheelers sales increased by 12.69 per cent in April-February 2019 over the same period last year. Within the Three Wheelers, passenger carrier sales

registered a growth of 13.39 per cent and goods carrier grew by 9.70 per cent in April-February 2019 over April-February 2018.

Two Wheelers sales registered a growth at 6.95 per cent in April-February 2019 over April-February 2018. Within the Two Wheelers segment, Scooters, Motorcycles and Mopeds grew by 1.81 per cent, 9.96 per cent and 3.64 per cent respectively in April-February 2019 over April-February 2018.

In April-February 2019, overall automobile exports grew by 15.54 per cent. While passenger vehicles exports declined by (-) 10.00 per cent, commercial vehicles, Three Wheelers and Two Wheelers registered a growth of 4.13 per cent, 48.59 per cent and 18.05 per cent respectively in April-February 2019 over the same period last year. ■
